



HHP RECIPROCITY POLICY

Adopted by Board 3/28/01

- 1) Visitors from member towns may attend any other member towns' collection at no charge provided that:
 - a) Their town has hosted or co-hosted a collection using the Cooperative's contract within the previous year and
 - b) They present a signed Visitor Authorization Form from their own town's Dept. of Public Works or Board of Health (whichever is responsible for paying for the service). Permission authorizes disposal at the expense of the resident's town. Proof of residency is required.
 - c) Their town pays the per car rate when billed. Volume discounts to the host town attended do not apply to the visitor rate.
 - d) Visitors may be authorized to dispose of an amount exceeding the "per car" quantity, but such excess authorization must be explicitly stated on the authorization form. The authorizing town will be billed for up to the number of car-equivalents authorized and presented for disposal at the collection.
- 2) Visitors with a quantity of material in excess of the amount authorized may pay for the excess amount to the vendor, or arrange with their town to dispose of it at a later date.
- 3) Visitors without permission may attend for the contract per car rate, paid to the vendor on site.
